	 Minor excavation to remove below- ground structures, including pipes and services. 	High-level noise and dust.
	Safe removal of hazardous materials, such as asbestos.

A professional demolition contractor with expertise in asbestos removal will undertake the main demolition works.





Will there be any impact on me or my family?

Our contractor will use control measures, such as dust suppression and noise reduction equipment to reduce impacts as much as possible.

All works will be managed in line with WorkSafe Victoria and Environment Protection Authority (EPA) Victoria regulations.
