

Homes Victoria is building more and better homes for people who need them most. As part of the Big Housing Build, we're replacing the former Elgin Towers with high-quality, secure, accessible and energy-efficient homes and community spaces.

Working together in 2025

We know that listening to the community is the most effective way to plan for and deliver new homes.

Across this year we hosted 18 drop-in sessions to introduce you to our project team, answer your questions and hear your thoughts.

Feedback and ideas from community members shaped the final design of the new apartments. A key theme from that feedback was the importance of apartments that meet the needs of different households. In response to this insight, the new apartments will offer a mix of bedrooms, ranging from one to five.

We're looking forward to next year, when construction of 248 new public housing apartments will get underway.


These new apartments will replace the 196 older apartments previously on the site - an almost 26% increase.

Demolition progress

Demolition work continues to progress well. We're now down to:

- Floor 8, Nicholson Street
- Floor 10, Elgin Street





Site safety over summer

Our project management team will monitor the site over the summer period.

The network of safety cameras will remain in operation and regular security patrols will continue.

The crane will be raised to a safe position and remain in place during this time.

Did you know

When not in use, cranes are set to a 'weathervane' setting, allowing them to slowly move according to the prevailing wind.
