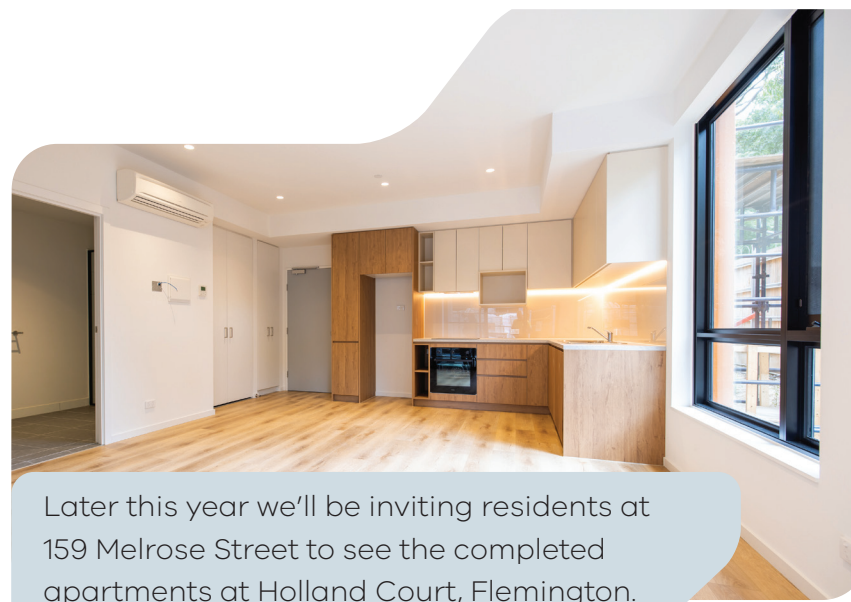


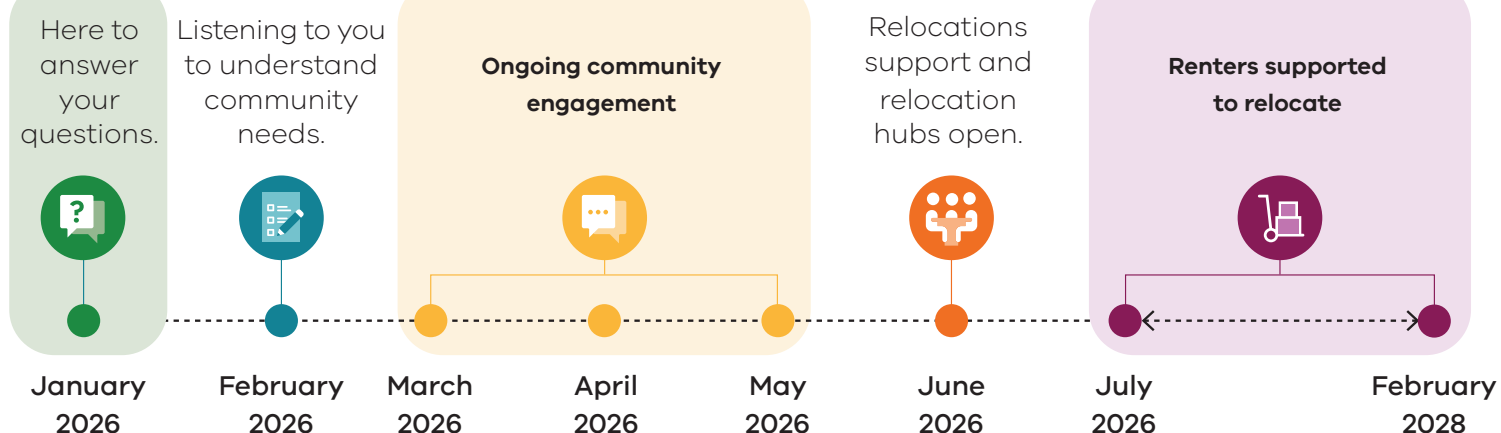
159 Melrose Street is part of the next stage of the high-rise redevelopment

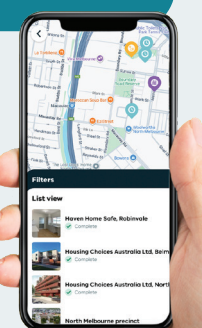

2025

1. Learning more and making things safe

- Securing vacant apartments
- Inspecting site and buildings to manage materials safely
- Continuing routine maintenance

2026: We are here

2. Getting ready

- ✓ Setting up site and signage for safety
- ✓ Checking service connections
- ✓ Making access safe for pedestrians, cars and car parking
- ✓ Working inside building to make safe and prepare for demolition

3. Demolition

- Installing scaffolding
- Taking out internal fittings
- Taking down building in careful stages
- Regular community updates

Residents currently relocating

Works

- Securing and making safe vacant apartments
- Removing some fixtures from vacant apartments
- Installing security gates due to finish before 16 February

Local Housing Office appointments

The local housing office team are now located at 12 Churchill Avenue, Ascot Vale
You can still contact the North Melbourne team:

- call or email your housing officer as usual
- call or email to make an appointment with your housing officer in North Melbourne
- drop in any time to the Ascot Vale office

Taking small samples of material in vacant apartments, corridors, lift areas and outside walls

- Inspections are starting on external walls
- Inspections will be at the west, east and southern ends of the building with small sections fenced at the ground for safety
- Workers use platforms to move up and down the building avoiding apartments still tenanted
- There will be short periods of minor drilling noises
- Contractors may work some Saturdays to make sure work is complete before Ramadan

Around the precinct

Security upgrades underway

- Contractors and authorities visiting on different days for site walks and inspections
- Checking service connections
- Land surveying for future safety around site boundaries

- Essential repair works underway October 2025 to June 2026
