

Works Notice - Simmons Street, South Yarra

Crane Removal – October 2025

Homes Victoria, together with project partner Building Communities including their builder ICON, is redeveloping the Simmons Street, South Yarra housing site to deliver 522 new social, affordable and market rental homes that are modern, accessible and sustainable.

As part of this work, the next two tower cranes will be removed from the Simmons Street site on:

- **Friday, 10 and Saturday 11 October 2025**
- **Friday 24 and Saturday 25 October 2025**

Works will take place between **7am to 6pm** on each of these days

What to Expect

Large trucks will remove the tower crane in sections. These trucks will enter the site via Gate 3 on Simmons Street and exit the site via Gate 1 on Surrey Road.

Please be aware there may be some additional noise due to truck movements.

Traffic management will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the site. Please refer to the map on the next page for details.

For those residents who have subscribed for live text message updates, we will let you know if works are impacted due to weather conditions.
