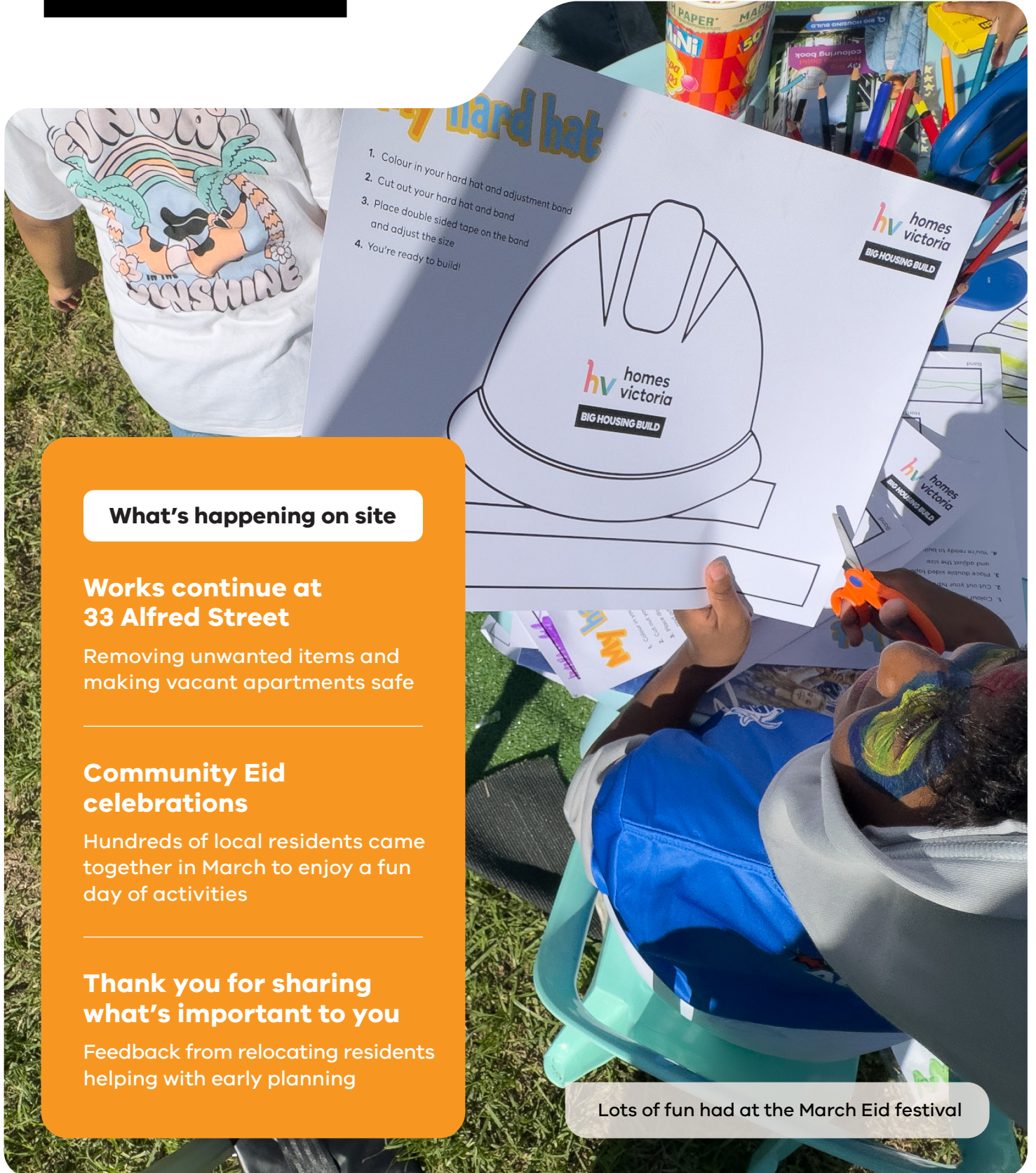

Works

- Securing and making safe vacant apartments
- Removing some fixtures from vacant apartments
- Security gate installation complete
- Taking small samples of materials from vacant apartments and corridors

Local Housing Office appointments

The local housing office team are now located at 12 Churchill Avenue, Ascot Vale. You can still contact the North Melbourne team:

- Call or email your housing officer as usual
- Drop in any time to the Ascot Vale office

Around the precinct

- Contractors and authorities visiting on different days for site walks and inspections
- Checking service connections
- Land surveying for future safety around site boundaries

Future redevelopment

- Essential repair works underway from April 2026 to December 2026
- Workers use platforms to access outside walls
- Workers in corridors, stairwells, laundries and drying rooms

76 Canning Street

Future redevelopment

- Essential repair works underway October 2025 to June 2026
- Workers use platforms to access outside walls
- Workers in corridors, stairwells, laundries and drying rooms
- Protective barriers in place for safety

Buncle Street Community Garden

- Upgrade works underway
- Includes beds moved from 33 Alfred Street
- Gardens due to reopen in coming weeks

What's happening at 33 Alfred Street

No demolition will occur while residents are living in these buildings.

We are here

- ✓ Setting up site and signage for safety
- ✓ Checking service connections
- ✓ Making access safe for pedestrians, cars and car parking
- ✓ Working inside buildings to make them safe
- ✓ Removing small fixtures from vacant apartments

Demolition

- Installing scaffolding
- Taking down building in careful stages
- Regular community updates

In February we surveyed relocating residents to learn more about the supports we can provide and to help us with early planning.

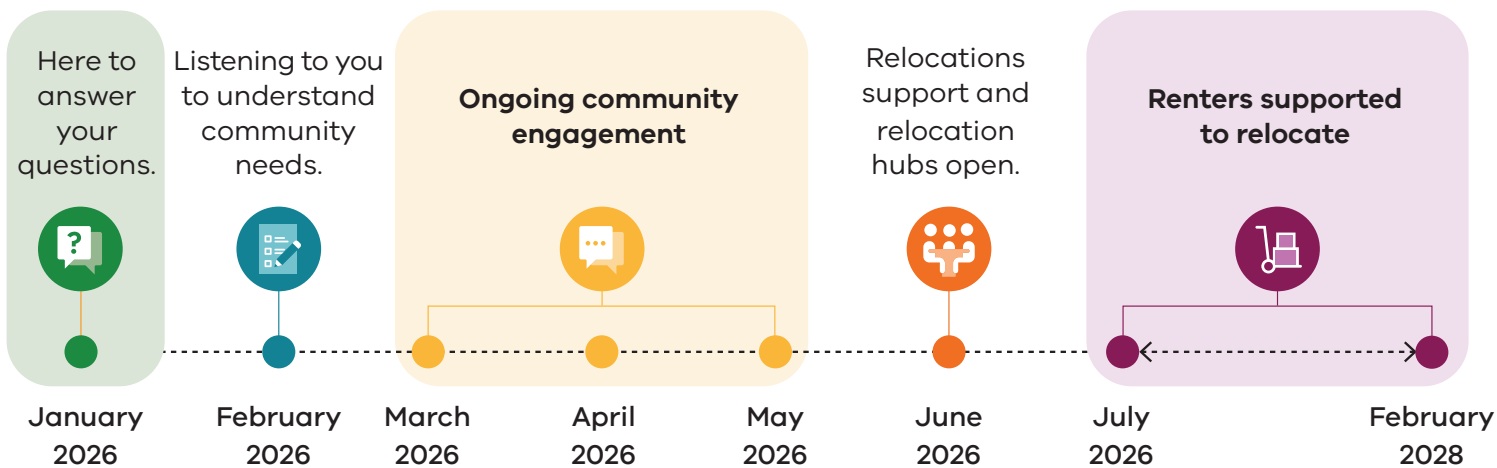
We heard great feedback on:

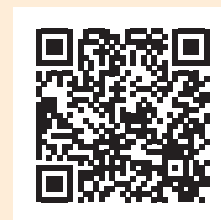
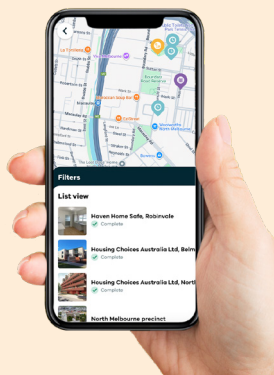
