Buncle Street gardens now open

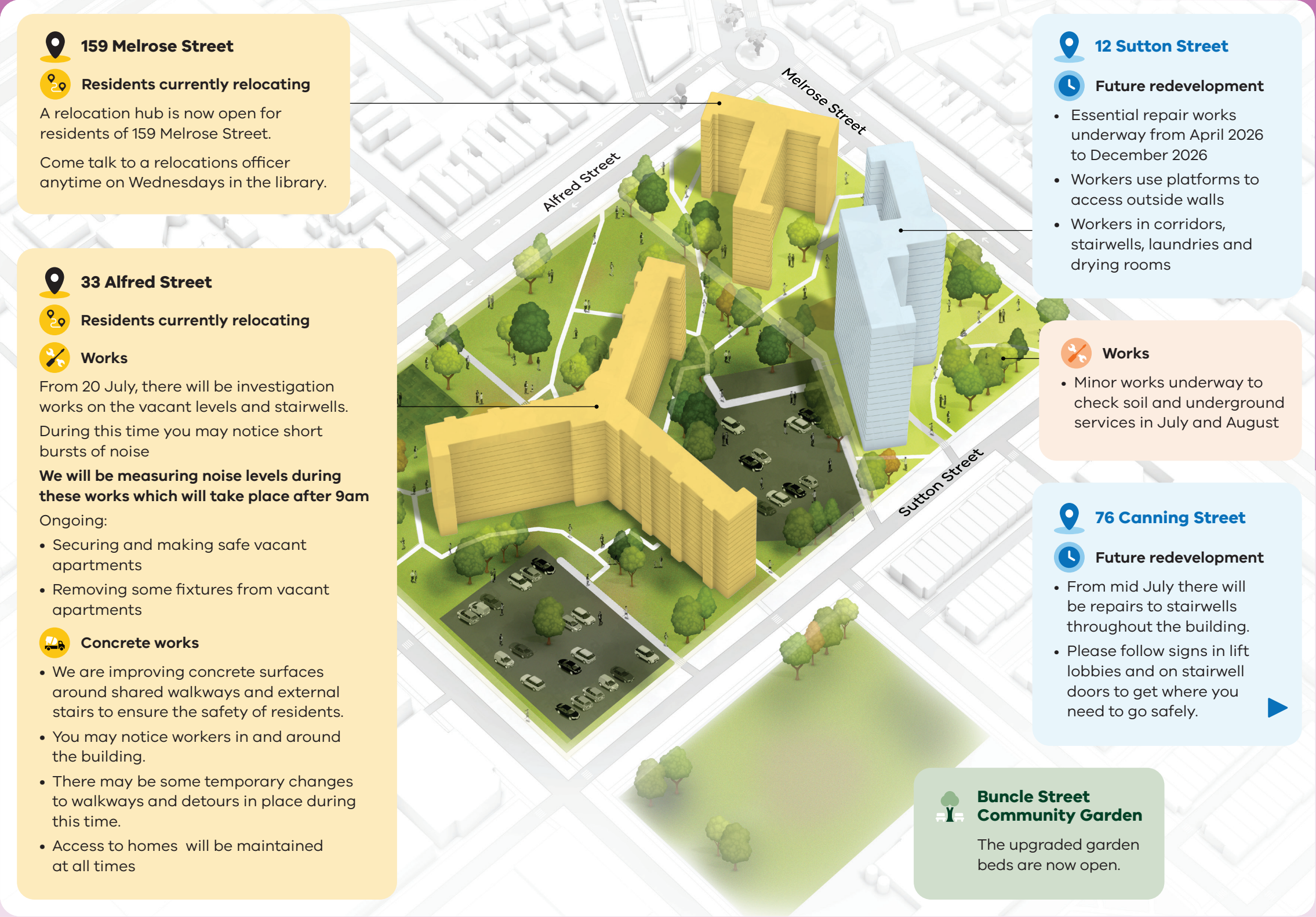
The garden beds relocated from 33 Alfred St have found their new home in the Buncle Street Community Garden.

July/August 2026



What's happening at 33 Alfred Street

No demolition will occur while residents are living in these buildings.

1. Learning more and making things safe

- ✓ Securing vacant apartments
- ✓ Inspecting site and buildings to manage materials safely
- ✓ Continuing routine maintenance

2. Getting ready

- Setting up site and signage for safety
- Checking service connections
- Making access safe for pedestrians, cars and car parking
- Working inside buildings to make them safe

3. Demolition

- Complete scaffolding
- Taking out internal fittings
- Taking down building in careful stages
- Regular community updates

All works are carried out to the highest safety standards and legal requirements.

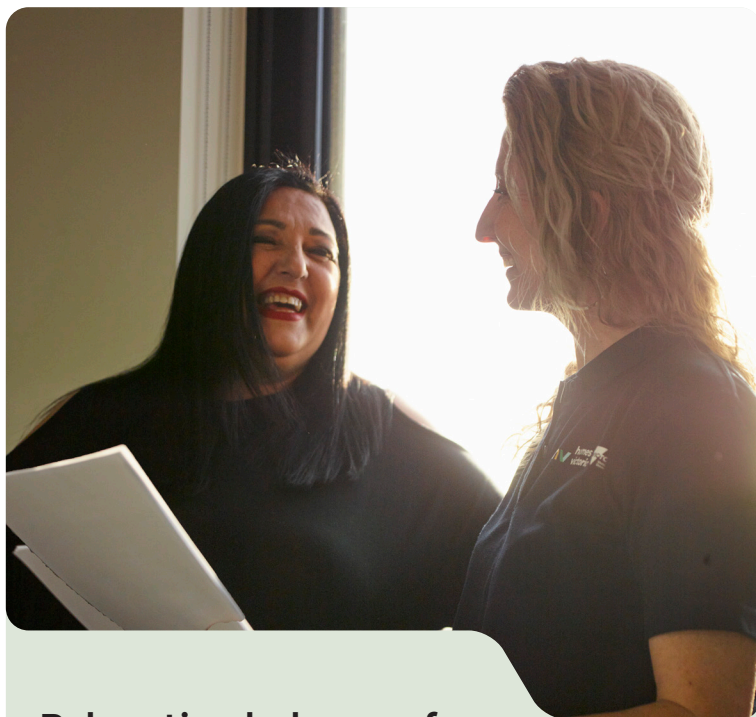

Relocation hub open for 159 Melrose St residents

Relocating residents can come and talk to a relocations officer in the library at 159 Melrose Street every Wednesday between 10-12pm.

Relocating residents can also contact your relocations officer via email or phone.

Your relocation officer will work with you to understand your needs. They will connect you to the right supports.

When you are ready, they will help you move to a suitable home.

Timeline for relocating residents at Melrose Street



February 2026

We heard from more than 300 residents who shared information to help us start planning.



May 2026

- Community Connector Committees meeting to ask questions and share information.
- Resident and family and friends information sessions continue.
- Better Health Network available to help residents needing extra support.



July 2026

- Dedicated relocations officers are reaching out to residents to set up the first conversation.
- Relocation hub will open to provide support close by.
- Residents offered tours of demonstration homes nearby.



Late 2026

New homes nearby complete and available for relocating residents.



February 2028

All residents have relocated.

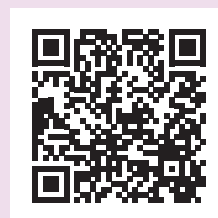
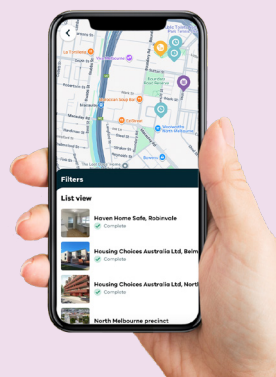
