Weekend electrical works

New Street, Brighton

Dear resident,

Construction is progressing well at the New Street, Brighton project site.

We are building 299 new sustainably designed social and private market rental homes, to give more Victorians a safe and secure place to call home. This project will also improve the local area by delivering better open space and landscaping for the community to enjoy.

We are writing to notify the community that we will be carrying out some electrical works over this weekend at the project site.

Electrical works

Electrical works are planned for this **Sunday 18 September, from 9 am – 4 pm** at the project site. Electrical power to the project site will be turned off to enable a new power connection to be installed. These works cannot be performed during normal weekday hours as the power needs to be disconnected from the whole project site for several hours.

What to expect

There will be no power disruption to your home or the neighbourhood.

A generator will be required during this time. This will be the only noise generated by the works and is expected to run for 30 minutes in the early afternoon.

The works to be undertaken have received approval from the relevant authorities.
